

AFTERCARE

Program Description/ Eligibility Criteria: Youth ages 14-18 age currently incarcerated for 40 plus days at James Ranch, Muriel Wright Center, or Juvenile Hall. Youth that are in need of Mental Health Services as determined by the Department of Mental Health. Youth must meet medical necessity for a mental health disorder according to Santa Clara County's policy to provide services.

Referral Sources/Referral Procedure: Youth set for release from the Ranches or Juvenile Hall ay have a referral made from the Santa Clara County Mental Health Department and the Santa Clara County Probation Department to the appropriate community-based organization. Once the County Mental Health Department has approved the referral, and the child is released, the agency Clinical Coordinator and/or the assigned staff member will contact the client and family to begin engagement.
