

Criminal Justice Transitional Housing Unit (THU)

Program Description: The Transitional Program consists of sober living housing for individuals involved with the criminal justice system enrolled in the Mental Health Service Act Full Service Partnership. During 180-day stay, clients are required to seek employment and resolve self-support issues as well as to participate actively in outpatient treatment at Community Solutions. The THU is currently located in Gilroy.

Eligibility Criteria: Adult male; 18 to 59 years old; enrolled in the Mental Health Service Act Full Service Partnership.

Referral Sources: County Probation, Courts, PALS, DADs or other social service agencies.

Referral Procedure: Appointment required; with assigned Case Manager.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: Sliding scale based on income.
