

Crossing Bridges

Program Description: This dual diagnosis program, Crossing Bridges, provides group and individual counseling for persons diagnosed with a mental health disorder and co-occurring substance abuse. Participants are provided an introduction to the strength-based ideal of responsibility for choice, and planning and skill development.

Eligibility Criteria: Participants must be at least 18 years old and be receiving or qualified for full scope MediCal/Uninsured. Participants must have a diagnosed mental disorder in addition to drug/alcohol dependence. Participants must meet medical necessity criteria for mental health services.

Referral Sources/Referral Procedures: Individuals can complete a mental health referral form and submit it fully completed to the Dual Diagnosis Intake Coordinator, or an applicant may telephone the Dual Diagnosis Intake Coordinator directly to make a referral.
