

## **Domestic Violence Legal Services**

**Program Description:** Legal services are for battered women and sexual assault survivors in need of legal assistance. The legal advocate provides assistance with Temporary Restraining Orders (TRO), court accompaniment, advocacy services, information and referrals. Services available Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (some evenings). Transportation to court appearances may be provided.

**Eligibility Criteria:** Victims of intimate partner violence and sexual assault only, due to funding requirements.

**Referral Sources:** Community members, police, social services, counselors, self-referral.

**Referral Procedures:** Call 1-877-363-7238 to set up appointment. Services available in English and Spanish.
