Family and Children Mental Health Services

Program Description: Family and Children (F&C) services provide mental health counseling to residents of South Santa Clara County. Services include outpatient individual, family and/or group therapy, case management services, and medication support services. Services are available to those that meet medical necessity for mental health services. These services are provided to those who have full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families, or no insurance.

Eligibility Criteria: Ages range up to 21 years; full scope Medi-Cal & or uninsured recipients.

Referral Sources: Self, Family, School, County Mental Health, Social Services, Juvenile Probation Department, and Community Agencies.

Referral Procedure: Complete a Family and Children Referral form and submit to assigned program coordinator – Lori Penn (temp)/MH Site. Call Center referrals also accepted.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or uninsured.
