Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR)

Program Description: The CDCR Program is intended to support parolee's with mental health diagnosis.

Basic Services Include: Mental health services, case management, dual diagnosis groups, medication services, 24/7 on-call services for individuals involved in the criminal justice system who are mentally ill with current substance abuse diagnosis.

Eligibility Criteria: Adults 18 to 59 years old enrolled in the Full Service Partnership Program and the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation.

Referral Source: All referrals originate with the Courts and the Parole Office.

Referral Procedure: Staff from Criminal Justice Full Service Partnership Program meets the parolee's at Evans Lane Program. Staff is assigned a referral and meets with the potential client.

Client Fees: MediCal billing or otherwise on cost.
