

Human Trafficking

Program Description: 24-Hour Crisis Line and Crisis Intervention services for victims of human trafficking. Advocacy services relating to law enforcement issues, court proceedings, access to benefits and immigration attorney, when appropriate. Supportive services towards independent living include safety planning, transportation, education, goal planning, and relevant community referrals. Services provided directly or via coalition advocates throughout the south bay.

Eligibility Criteria: Individuals recruited by force, fraud or coercion for the purpose of sexual or labor exploitation.

Referral Procedure: Law enforcement, government and non-governmental organizations contacts the South Bay Coalition to End Human Trafficking Chair, Perla Flores, via our 24-hour crisis line or at her office. Self-referrals access the program as walk-ins or via our crisis line.
