

Name of Program: Independent Living Skills ProgramProgram Description:

- Individual and group sessions on daily living skills
- Youth in eligible out-of-home placement (including some probation youth and most foster care youth, ages 16 to 21, male/female)
- South and East San Jose, Morgan Hill, San Martin, Gilroy, and Advent Youth Ministries

Eligibility Criteria: Youth, 16 to 21 years old, who are currently in eligible out-of-home placement, or who were in out-of-home placement for a period after their 16th birthday.

Referral Sources: DSS / Probation / ILP Team.

Referral Procedure: Social workers, probation officers, and/or ILP team complete a Transitional Independent Living Skills Plan (TILP) as a referral with potentially eligible youth and submit it to the ILP Coordinator at Santa Clara County's Department of Social Services for approval.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: Contract program with Santa Clara County. Youth from out-of-county are charged to their county of origin. No fee to clients.
