Name of Program: La Isla Pacifica Women's Shelter

Program Description: Domestic Violence Shelter for women and children fleeing abusive situations. Clients may stay up to 45 days. Supportive services towards independent living include safety planning, transportation, education, counseling, legal assistance, food, clothing and other appropriate community referrals. Confidential location in South Santa Clara County.

Eligibility Criteria: Women and children – boys over the age of 12 not allowed due to communal living situation.

Referral Sources: We accept referrals from all sources.

Referral Procedure: Client should call 408-683-4118 and ask for the shelter. Shelter staff will do a telephone screening and then meet face-to-face with client.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: No charge for services.
