

System of Care Mental Health Services (SOC)

Program Description: System of Care (SOC) mental health services provides mental health counseling to residents of South Santa Clara County. We provide intensive in-home support services to children and youth in the Juvenile Justice System and/or working with a Social Worker from the Social Services Department. Services include outpatient individual, family and /or group therapy, case management services and medication support services. Services are provided at the agency, school, and/or home. Services are available to those who meet the medical necessity for mental health services. These services are provided to those who have full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or no insurance.

Eligibility Criteria: Full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or uninsured. Individuals must be wards or dependents of the court, in foster care or kinship care (not in group home), and /or have an open case file with Social Services or Juvenile Probation Department.

Referral Sources/Referral Procedure: Referrals should come directly from Department of Family and Child Services or Juvenile Probation Department.
