Status Offender Services – 601 Crisis Counseling Services

Program Description: Youth, up to 17 years of age, are provided assessment, crisis intervention, and referral services. Follow-up services include individual counseling, case management, and family intervention, as well as referrals to other resources to stabilize the family and prevent reoccurrences of status offender behavior. Youth are limited to a maximum of 10-15 sessions.

Eligibility Criteria: Youth, up to 17 years old, who are not classified as 602 status in the legal system.

Referral Sources: Accepted from all sources.

Referral Procedure: Contact Monica Cruz at 408-846-4709 to schedule an appointment, walk-in, or call out on crisis basis. Services are offered at Community Solutions' Gilroy (Chestnut St.) and Morgan Hill (Church St.) sites and at school sites.
