

Status Offender Services – (SOS) 601 Crisis Counseling Services

Program Description: 24 hour crisis line (408-683-4118) services for youth ages 10 to 17 years old who are at-risk, experiencing family conflict, school related problems, truancy, homelessness, curfew, and/or behavioral problems. Youth are provided assessment, crisis intervention, case management and counseling services. Goal is to stabilize the individual and/or family and prevent reoccurrences of status offender behavior.

Eligibility Criteria: Youth 10 to 17 years old who are at-risk.

Referral Sources: Accepted from all sources.

Referral Procedure: Contact Program Coordinator at 408-846-4743 to schedule an appointment, walk-in, or call out on crisis basis.
