

STOP (Supportive and Therapeutic Options Program)

Program Description: Services provide mental health counseling to residents of Southern Santa Clara County. Services include outpatient individual, family and/or group therapy, case management services, and medication support services. Services are available to those that meet medical necessity for mental health services. These services are provided to those who have no insurance.

Eligibility Criteria: Uninsured

Referral Sources: Referrals made by County Mental Health

Referral Procedure: Referral form should be completed and then submitted to the assigned Clinical Program Coordinator. Call Center referrals are also accepted.
