

Teen Assault Awareness Program

Program Description: This program is designed to teach teens, ages 11-18, how to recognize the different types of abuse and how to deal effectively with potentially abusive situations. Sexual assault, domestic violence, and the myths vs. realities of abuse are discussed. This is a primary prevention program that empowers teens to take action and question old beliefs.

Eligibility Criteria: Teens ages 11 – 18, Jr. High to high school level. Areas served are Gilroy, Morgan Hill, South San Jose, and San Benito County.

Referral Procedure: Contact Assistant Program Director to schedule presentation – 1-3 hour presentations per classroom.
