

Family and Children Mental Health Services (F&C)

Program Description: Family and Children (F&C) services provide mental health counseling to residents of South Santa Clara County. Services include outpatient individual, family and/or group therapy, case management services, and medication support services. Services are available to those that meet medical necessity for mental health services. These services are provided to those who have full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families, or no insurance.

Eligibility Criteria: Ages range up to 21 years; full scope Medi-Cal.

Referral Sources/Referral Procedure: Referrals can be made by; Self, Family, School, County Mental Health, Social Services, Juvenile Probation Department, and Community Agencies. A Family and Children Referral form should be completed and then submitted to the assigned clinical program coordinator – Dee Dimitri-Salvato, LMFT. Call Center referrals are also accepted.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: Medi-Cal, Healthy Families with MediCal.
