

Name of Program: System of Care Mental Health Services

Program Description: System of Care (SOC) mental health services provides mental health counseling to residents of South Santa Clara County. SOC services provide intensive in-home support services to children and youth in the Juvenile Justice system and/or working with a Social Worker from the Social Services Department. Services include outpatient individual, family and/or group therapy, case management services and medication support services. Services are provided at the agency, school, and/or home. Services are available to those who meet medical necessity for mental health services. These services are provided to those who have full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or no insurance.

Eligibility Criteria: Full-scope Medi-Cal, Healthy Families or uninsured. Individuals must be wards or dependents of the court, in foster care or kinship care (not in group home), and/or have an open case with Social Services.

Referral Sources: Self, Family, School, County Mental Health, Social Services, Juvenile Probation Department, and Community Agencies.

Referral Procedure: Referrals should come directly from the Social Workers and Probation Officers. Minors on probation must have been adjudicated and on formal probation.

Client Fees and Payment Requirements: Full scope MediCal, Healthy Families or uninsured.

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
