Course Description: In this course, participants will learn about the importance of safety when working in community-based behavioral health settings. It will teach learners how to use safety precautions while working in the field delivering services and conducting meetings in client's homes.

By the conclusion of this workshop, participants will be able to identify and practice:

- To understand the principals of preparation and be able to apply them in the four main areas: car, phone, dress and location.
- To be able to assess the environment and the client safety throughout the four stages of contact: pre-arrival, approach, first contact and ongoing.
- To know 3 ways to respond should staff safety become a concern at any point in the four stages.

Matthew T Rensi, Ph. D., LPCC. is a Licensed Professional Clinical Counselor who also holds a Ph. D. in counselor education and supervision. He has extensive experience providing therapy to people struggling with psychosis, homelessness, various mental health issues and the legal system.
