I lived in fear and did not like going to school due to feeling unsafe no matter where I went. I would have nightmares and constantly think about the people that hurt me," says Aitana, age 14.

Aitana's family fled Mexico to escape death threats from the cartel, leaving behind everything – family, friends, community, and Aitana's beloved childhood dog.

Due to the violence she experienced, Aitana lost trust in people and lived in constant fear. She couldn't focus in the present moment. She struggled to manage family life and academics and even to make friends.

Thanks to your generosity, Aitana was able to get the specialized mental health care she needed to heal from her trauma. Her treatment team gained her trust through patience, kindness,

and consistency.

In therapy, Aitana learned to identify her triggers and understand her experiences and the emotional and physical symptoms that she developed because of her trauma. She learned healthy coping skills, such as breathing techniques, talking to others, and journaling. "I learned to calm myself and manage my emotions through interventions to support myself in feeling better and not focus on the past but in the present moment," she says.

Thanks to you, Aitana no longer lives in fear. Today, she is smiling, social, doing well in school, and hopeful for her future. What a gift!

With new dentures, Jonnie's self-confidence has improved dramatically and The care team also referred Jonnie to a local free bike program which has made Javi's school commute more fun and manageable. Father and son can now enjoy a 15-minute bike ride to school instead of an hourlong bus ride.
