Maria is done walking on eggshells

Thanks to you, she can live her life without fear today

For 10 years, Maria's husband controlled every aspect of her life. To even consider making her own decision was dangerous. She says it was like "walking on eggshells."

"I felt lost, hopeless, and I did not know that there was help for me and for women like me dealing with an abusive partner," she says.

Thanks to you and your generosity, Maria was able to get the support she needed to regain control of her life, find lasting safety, and heal from the years of abuse.

When Maria was referred to us by the local police, she was immediately assigned an advocate who supported her with peer counseling, safety planning, legal advocacy, and more. She also engaged in therapy to focus on her healing and recovery.

Maria felt worthless at first,

that her emotions didn't matter. Sometimes she'd skip therapy just to avoid sharing her feelings. Her therapist focused on building Maria's coping skills. They practiced during every session so Maria could use her new skills in the week ahead.

As she learned to express herself, Maria also slowly

regained power and control in her life. "Therapy has helped me learn how to live with challenges in my life and find those solutions," she says.

Thanks to you, Maria is safe and more confident today. She speaks up for herself and knows that her voice matters. What a gift!

Safely home from the streets

Thanks to you, Christen is housed and finally receiving the mental health care she needs

With severe paranoia and auditory and visual hallucinations, Christen, now age 33, existed in her own reality for many years and self-medicated through substance use. She lived in a tent by the creek, where she was both physically and sexually assaulted.


Christen was eventually placed on a psychiatric hold, then hospitalized due to severe self-neglect. On release, she was referred to our Intensive Case Management program for mental health care and supportive housing services.

Thanks to you, Christen was finally able to get the mental health care and substance use treatment she needed, including access to psychiatric care and medications.

At first, Christen didn't trust people and found it difficult to hold a conversation. However, she appreciated how her treatment team showed up for her consistently, even when she was struggling.

When Christen was evicted from her housing and relapsed into substance use, her treatment team did not give up on her. Instead, they helped her find a new placement and continued to provide her with support and services.

Christen is housed and has over a year of sobriety. She feels good to be on her own again and continues to grow in mental health treatment. "Time heals all wounds," she says.

Was late for junior year and getting out of foster care," says 17-year-old Braelyn. "It was a difficult time going back with my mom; [we] shared a room, shared a bed."

As Braelyn transitioned back to living with her mom, she struggled to set goals for herself and to balance school and life.

Through your generosity, Braelyn was able to get the extra support she needed through our Independent Living Program. The program promotes life skills to help youth involved in foster care successfully transition to independent living and self-sufficiency.

At first, Braelyn thought, "here's just another new person [in my life]," so why bother? She wasn't motivated to engage and didn't return calls.

But her advocates kept reaching out, working to build rapport through Braelyn's favorite things, like getting
